Comments: Pennsylvania Privateer Brigantine *Dart* was commissioned on 12 June 1781 under Commander Thomas Davis of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Richard Minors of Philadelphia served aboard as First Mate. She was listed as having a battery of twelve guns and a crew of thirty-six men. *Dart's* \$20000 bond was signed by Davis and by Robert Shewell and John Lucas, both of Philadelphia.¹
