Comments: Pennsylvania Privateer Brigantine *Delaware* was commissioned on 23 April 1781 under Commander Richard Inkson of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. William Martin of Philadelphia served aboard as First Mate. She was listed as having a battery of four guns and a crew of seventeen men. *Delaware's* \$20000 bond was signed by Inkson and by James Ash of Philadelphia.¹
