Comments: Connecticut Privateer Brigantine *Diana* was commissioned on 29 October 1782 under Commander Seth Harding of New London, Connecticut. She was listed as having a battery of six guns and a crew of fifteen men. *Diana's* \$20000 bond was signed by Harding and by David Trumbull and John Alden, both of Lebanon, Connecticut.¹ This vessel had previously been commissioned as Massachusetts Privateer Brig *Diana* (Commander Robert Cushing).
