Comments: Pennsylvania Privateer Brigantine *Diana* was commissioned on 12 December 1780 under Commander Henry Hawkins of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Joseph Vansise of Philadelphia served aboard as First Mate. She was listed as having a battery of ten guns and a crew of thirty men. Her \$20000 bond was signed by Hawkins and by John Imlay of Philadelphia.¹
