Comments: Massachusetts Privateer Brigantine *Dispatch* was commissioned on 22 September 1780 under Commander Daniel Jacobs of Boston, Massachusetts. She was listed as having a battery of eight guns and a crew of twelve men. *Dispatch*'s \$20000 bond was signed by Jacobs and by Silas Smith and Elisha Sigourney, both of Boston.¹
