Comments: Massachusetts Privateer Brigantine *Dolly* was commissioned on 10 July 1782 under Commander Edward Davis of Boston, Massachusetts. She was listed as having a battery of six guns and a crew of ten men. *Dolly*'s \$20000 bond was signed by Davis and by Solomon Davis and Nicholas Bowie, both of Boston.<sup>1</sup>
