Comments: Pennsylvania Privateer Schooner *Dolphin* was commissioned on 16 June 1781 under Commander John Walsh of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. John Goodwin of Philadelphia served aboard as First Mate. She was listed as having a battery of six guns and a crew of eleven men. Her \$20000 bond was signed by James Oellers and John Flavahan, both of Philadelphia.¹
