Comments: Pennsylvania Privateer Schooner *Don Quixotte* was commissioned on 12 August 1782 under Commander John Burrows of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. She was listed as having a battery of six guns and a crew of sixteen men. *Don Quixotte's* \$20000 bond was signed by Burrows and by John W. Stanly of Philadelphia.¹
