Comments: The 120-ton Maryland Privateer Brigantine¹ [Brig]² *Donia Antoney* was commissioned on 29 November 1779 under Commander John Harr³ of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.⁴ The commission was dated 25 September 1779. She was listed as having a battery of ten guns and a crew of thirty-two men. The brigantine's owners were listed as George Meade & Co. of Philadelphia.⁵ *Donia Antoney*'s \$10000 bond was signed by Harr and by James Williams of Annapolis, Maryland.⁶
