Comments: The 70-ton Maryland Privateer Brig *Duke of Leinster* was commissioned on 19 June 1780 under Commander Clement Warring¹ of Annapolis, Maryland.² She was listed as having a battery of four guns and a crew of fourteen men. Her owners are listed as George Crookshanks & Co. of Baltimore, Maryland.³ Her \$20000 bond was signed by Warring and by John Davidson of Annapolis.⁴
